Enacted Mandatory Reporting Legislation

Public Act 06-142 creates an 11-member Committee on Healthcare Associated Infections responsible for developing, operating, and monitoring a mandatory reporting system for healthcare-associated infections. The Committee will provide a report to the Department of Public Health by October 1, 2007 detailing the appropriate standardized measures, reporting measures, and processes designed to prevent healthcare associated infections. The first annual report will be made public on October 1, 2008.
