<b>Data Submissions Intake and Processing</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Intake and processing of up to 80 submitters through Q4 2019 including Medicare, dental, and worker's compensation; non-claims data sources as summary values; value adds; Claims Data Manager (CDM) licensing; grouper application.
<b>Activity Deliverables:</b> Q1 – Q4 2020 Data Submissions Intake Q1 – Q4 2020 CDM Licensing Q1 – Q4 2020 Grouper application - MS DRGs
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$631,040

**Approach: Data Submissions Intake and Processing**

- Process submitted data through Onpoint CDM's data checks and validations, including updating the master patient and provider indices
- Grant and process waivers, extensions, and variances and issue notices of non-compliance
- Track submitter status and produce weekly submitter status reports for the Lead Organization and Lead Org. indicating compliance, indicating the compliance status of submitters
- Receive and map extracts of Medicare files from the U.S. Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), incorporate Medicare member data into the WA-APCD, convert CMS-supplied identifiers to conform to WA-APCD specifications, incorporate mapped Medicare data within appropriate data products
- Leverage Onpoint's Onpoint CDM online portal for use by Washington's data submitters, including credentialing, using passwords, menu options, and posted reference files
- Run and apply MS DRGs for inclusion within appropriate data products

<b>Data Completeness Reporting</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Data completeness reporting by submitter, product type, file type and provider type.
<b>Activity Deliverables:</b> Q1 – Q4 2020 Completeness Report
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$42,000

**Approach: Data Completeness Reporting**

- Produce Completeness Report for WA-APCD Data Submitters
  - Data submitter by product type, percentage populated by file type (eligibility, medical, pharmacy), and percentage populated by provider type (e.g., billing, prescribing, rendering, etc.)

<b>Analytic Enclave – Licenses and Data Product Refreshes</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Host all Office of Financial Management (Lead Org.) and WA-APCD End User Analytic Enclave licenses; perform quarterly refreshes to standard and customized data products; release data product refreshes to end users within the Analytic Enclave
<b>Activity Deliverables:</b> Q1 – Q4 2020 Analytic Enclave End User and Lead Org. Licenses Q1 – Q4 2020 Standard Datasets #1 and #2 Q1 – Q4 2020 Customized Dataset #1 Q1 – Q4 2020 Customized Dataset #2 Q1 – Q4 2020 Customize Dataset #3
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$200,200

**Approach: Analytic Enclave – Licenses and Data Product Refreshes**

- Host, maintain, and provide technical support for up to 25 individual WA Analytic Enclave end user licenses
- Fees include one no-cost and two ‘read only’ Lead Org. licenses
- Additional individual end user licenses (beyond 25) can be purchased for \$400/month/license
- Perform quarterly refreshes of Standard Data Set #1 – Cost and Provider (C+P), no Medicare data
  - Release into the WA Analytic Enclave environment to permitted end users
- Perform quarterly refreshes of Standard Data Set #2 – Cost and Provider (C+P), Medicare data included
  - Release into the WA Analytic Enclave environment to permitted end users
- Perform quarterly refreshes of Customized Dataset #1
  - Release into the WA Analytic Enclave environment to permitted end users
- Perform quarterly refreshes of Customized Dataset #2
  - Release into the WA Analytic Enclave environment to permitted end users
- Perform quarterly refreshes of Customized Dataset #3
  - Release into the WA Analytic Enclave environment to permitted end users

<b>Performance Reporting Portal (PRP) – Hosting and Technical Maintenance</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Ongoing technical maintenance of the PRP
<b>Activity Deliverables:</b> Q1 – Q4 2020 PRP Hosting and Technical Maintenance
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$60,000

**Approach: Performance Reporting Portal (PRP) – Technical Reestablishment and End User Support**

- Perform PRP hosting, ongoing technical maintenance services, and code updates (as needed)

<b>Data Submission Guide (DSG) Annual Review</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Perform annual review of WA-APCD DSG; propose recommended updates for Lead Org. review and sign off; perform updates to record layout and connector to accommodate any/all DSG changes; update documentation and communicate changes to data submitters
<b>Activity Deliverable:</b> Q3 2020 DSG Annual Review, System Updates and Submitter Support
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$30,000 [not to exceed]

**Approach: Data Submission Guide (DSG) Annual Review**

- Perform full review of WA-APCD DSG
- Propose recommended updates to Lead Org. for review and sign off
- Perform development to record layout and connector to accommodate for all Lead Org.- approved file updates
- Update DSG documentation and any other associated materials, distribute to all participating data submitters
- Communicate DSG updates to all participating data submitters within a timely manner (noting the 120-day pre-submitter implementation notification period)
- Host a webinar to review DSG updates with all participating data submitters

<b>Performance Reporting Portal (PRP) – Attribution and Roster Updates</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Refresh provider attribution, perform outreach, and make any necessary roster updates within the PRP.
<b>Activity Deliverable:</b> Q4 2020 Provider attribution, roster outreach and updates
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$51,500

**Approach: Performance Reporting Portal (PRP) – Attribution and Roster Updates**

- Perform a refresh of the WA-APCD provider attribution and compare against existing provider roster to identify additional providers who meet WA PRP roster/reporting criteria
- Working in collaboration with WA-APCD Lead Organization to:
  - Research potential roster updates and conduct outreach to providers identified via attribution refresh
  - Explore alternate sources for informing updates to the WA roster
  - Manually update WA roster within the PRP, as necessary

<b>Activity Description:</b>
<b>Activity Deliverables:</b> Q4 2020 Post-R&R Measure Reconciliation Support
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$14,000

**Approach: Performance Reporting Portal (PRP) – Review and Reconsideration (R&R) Support**

- End user support including the refresh and redistribution of individual end user passwords, review and updates to portal documentation and training materials, and conducting training webinars, as needed
- Review and reconcile provider-requested reporting reconsiderations, including performing outreach and conducting meetings, as needed, to determine final outcome of reconsideration data
- Perform QA of the areas included above

<b>WA HealthCareCompare Website Reporting Refresh</b>
<b>Activity Description:</b> Perform all necessary reporting updates, generate and deliver results into 2019 website extract to Forum One
<b>Activity Deliverables:</b> Q4 2020 Common Measure Set reporting Q4 2020 Reliability Scoring Q4 2020 Public Use File Refresh
<b>Deliverable Payment:</b> \$63,950

**Approach: WA HealthCareCompare Website Reporting Refresh**

- Refresh and load Measurement Year (MY) 2018 Common Measure Set reporting
- Perform and load medical practice, facility and provider reporting summarizations
- Refresh service price reporting, star-ratings, performance categories and reliability scoring to accommodate WA website reporting structure
- Refresh Public Use File to contain most recent/available calendar year (2019) reporting
