About NAHDO

The National Association of Health Data Organizations (NAHDO) is a not-for-profit national membership organization. We are dedicated to improving health care through the collection, analysis, dissemination, public availability, and use of health data. NAHDO serves the interests of health data organizations, academic institutions, policy makers, healthcare systems, payers, and many others that have a common interest in the availability of high quality and timely health data to inform questions of cost, quality, and access to care.

NAHDO was created in the spring of 1985 by the Washington Business Group on Health (WBGH) and the Intergovernmental Health Policy Project (IHPP) at George Washington University. It was designed to assist state health data organizations, state agencies, and the public by creating, exchanging, and providing information and resources that promote the effective collection, analysis, and dissemination of health care data.

Today, the membership includes state agencies, federal agencies, health care vendors, associations, consulting groups, and others interested in the collection and use of health data.

As the only organization of its kind, NAHDO gives a collective voice to members of the public and private sectors. NAHDO's success is linked inexorably to its members, their involvement in the association, and their commitment to achieving NAHDO's mission.

What is the APCD Council?

The All-Payer Claims Database (APCD) Council is a program of NAHDO. It is a national learning collaborative that is jointly administered by NAHDO and the University of New Hampshire's Institute for Health Policy and Practice. It supports health data organizations that have expanded their reporting systems to include All-Payer Claims Databases (APCDs). APCD Council participants include government, private, non-profit, and academic organizations focused on improving the development and deployment of state-based APCDs.

The APCD Council:

- Serves in an information sharing capacity for those states who have developed, or are developing, all-payer claims databases.
- Provides technical assistance to states and entities interested in developing APCDs.
- Catalyzes efforts to achieve mutual goals.

2020 NAHDO Awards

NAHDO is pleased to announce the following recognitions that will take place at the conference.

Innovation in Data Dissemination Award

Massachusetts eHealth Collaborative

Join us for the award presentation on Tuesday, August 18, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. EDT

Since 2009, NAHDO has honored distinguished organizations with the Innovation in Data Dissemination Award. The Board of Directors established this award to recognize the importance of effectively communicating health data to the public. The Award Committee recognizes the Massachusetts eHealth Collaborative as the recipient of the 2020 Innovation in Data Dissemination Award.

The Massachusetts eHealth Collaborative (MAeHC) has been a pioneer and national leader in health information technology for over 15 years and is winding down its operations in 2020. The organization was originally formed to improve the safety, quality, and cost-effectiveness of healthcare in Massachusetts and the surrounding region through the creation and promotion of health information technologies. These technologies allow hospitals, physicians, and other provider organizations to immediately access critical patient medical information. This non-profit organization has worked alongside organizations from across the healthcare continuum to support their meaningful adoption of technology. MAeHC has also played a major role in advising and leading various industry initiatives in interoperability, standards development, and health IT policy. "I couldn't be prouder of what MAeHC has accomplished since its inception," said Lawrence Garber, MD, Chairman of the Board of MAeHC. "As the company enters this final phase, we can look back at a job well done, with highlights that include making the first interoperable healthcare community in the country, as well as creating an effective and affordable analytics and event-notification infrastructure that helped improve the care of millions of patients around the country." NAHDO is pleased to recognize MAeHC's seminal role in extracting data from electronic health record systems and promoting the use of this data to improve quality and enhance efficiency.

Elliot M. Stone Award for Excellence in Health Leadership Suanne Singer and Al Prysunka

Join us for the award presentation on Tuesday, August 25, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. EDT

In 1990, NAHDO created the NAHDO Award of Excellence in Health Leadership. This award recognizes individuals who represent the highest ideals in data collection, analysis, or outcomes measurement and whose creative efforts have made outstanding contributions to improvements in the collection, application, and/or dissemination of health data. After his death in 2005, the award was renamed to honor Elliot M. Stone, a pioneer in health data and information.

The Award Committee recognizes Al Prysunka and Suanne Singer as recipients of the 2020 Elliot M. Stone Award. Their combined dedication to the cause of using data to improve health paved the way for one of the most important advancements in state health data in recent memory: **the development of all-payer claims databases (APCD).** Because of their vision and leadership, today over thirty entities collect multi-payer healthcare claims data that are being used to better understand the cost and quality of healthcare.

Suanne Singer, the former president of Onpoint Health Data (previously the Maine Health Information Center), and Al Prysunka, the former Executive Director of the Maine Health Data Organization (MHDO) led the construction of the nation's first APCD, nearly 20 years ago for the State of Maine. Together Suanne and Al identified the challenges associated with the collection and processing of claims data. They also collaborated with various stakeholders to find the common ground and worked tirelessly to overcome the political and technical impediments. They set the framework for both what to collect in an APCD and how to build one. Because of their leadership, today there are over 30 entities that are collecting multi-payer health care claims data.

- **High-speed internet** A hard-wired internet connection is preferred; a secure private wireless network is the next best thing.

Conference Registration

The <u>registration site</u> will be open until November 14, 2020. NAHDO will transfer all registrations from the registration system to the Accelevents platform. Once your registration is successfully transferred, you will get an automated email from Accelevents that includes the link to the <u>NAHDO Event Site</u> (https://www.accelevents.com/e/nahdo).

Confirm Your Account Access in Accelevents

In order to participate, you will need to create a login to Accelevents. Please complete the account creation process as soon as possible to ensure that you are ready when NAHDO2020 kicks off on Monday!

 You should have received an automated email from Accelevents confirming that your NAHDO Conference registration has been activated. If not, please let us know.

- If you have not already created an Accelevents login for another event or testing session, you will be prompted to create a password.

- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** All **NAHDO** registrants will **also** receive an automated email from the **NASHP** system that will allow you to access two NAHDO-NASHP crossover events (see next section for more details). The emails will be similar but the **links are different**.


Once you receive the email from Accelevents, you can set up your attendee account on the Event Site. You must use the email address included in your confirmation email from Accelevents. The first time you enter the Event Site, you will be asked to create a password. Remember it in case you need to use it to attend the live event.

At the Event Site, you can preview the Agenda, Sponsors, and Exhibitors. On the agenda, you will see a "Register" button for each event. Registration is *not* required, however, using the function will allow you to build a personalized agenda. Networking sessions will have capacity limits.


The Event Lobby

- On Monday, August 17, the lobby will open no later than 11:30 a.m. Eastern Time. Return to the **Event Site** and you will be able to click on "**Enter Event**" to enter the **Event Lobby.**
- From the Lobby, you can view the conference agenda, identify and join sessions, interact with exhibitors in the Exhibit Hall, work on the Daily Puzzle at the mid-session Meet-Up, and find people to connect with.
 - **Pro Tip**: In the "Lobby", the **Agenda** page will allow you to **Join** sessions directly.

What's on the Lobby Page

- Navigation bar On the left, the blue bar has a set of links that will take you to specific areas of the conference: Plenary/Breakout Sessions, Networking Sessions, Daily Puzzle Meetups, The Exhibit Hall, and the Participant Directory.
- Conference Main Feed General announcements will show up in the Feed
- Sponsors You can see and connect with our conference sponsors.
- Agenda A full agenda will allow you to find sessions, speakers and other activities that you are interested in.
- Leadership See how you stack up in the Gamification leadership. The top 25 will be entered into a drawing!
- Chat window You can participate in live-feed chat environment. Channels are available for each session or for the conference as a whole.

Update Your Profile

We highly recommend that you update your profile by adding your photo, contact information, and a little about yourself. This will make it easier for you to network with other attendees.

How to Watch and Participate in a Plenary or Breakout Session

A few minutes before the start of a session, you can return to the Lobby and select a session from either the Agenda or Plenary/Breakout Sessions link. Click to **Join** sessions that are happening live or **View Recording** of a session you may have missed.

Types of sessions:

- Plenary Sessions A session intended for all participants. Pre-selected speakers and moderators will present on topics of general interest.
- Breakout Sessions Pick your choice of two sessions held at the same time. Don't worry if you want to see two at the same time. Sessions will be recorded and posted for viewing later.
- Daily Puzzle Meet-Ups In this unique session type, participants will be matched up for a three minute one-on-one video chat. At the end of three minutes, the meet-up ends and participants are matched with new people for a new three minute session.
- Networking Sessions Small groups of attendees will be hosted for an open discussion about a particular topic.

Asking Questions

Use the Q&A function on the chat bar inside the session. The staff member in each session will monitor the questions and pass them to the moderator during designated times.

Daily Puzzles

To encourage networking and cooperation, this year's conference will feature the NAHDO Daily Puzzle. Networking Opportunities

 Immediately after, we will open up hosted networking sessions. Each session will be organized around a topic or theme. These "workshop" format events will allow up to 20 attendees to get

together to discuss specific issues or ideas. In order to make them effective, capacity is limited. If your first choice is full, try another one.

- **Note:** You must have your webcam and microphone enabled and shared with Accelevents to participate.
- **Contacts and communications** In the Lobby, you will see a link that says "People." This link will give you a list of all of the attendees in the conference by name.

- You can request to Connect with any of them. If they accept your invitation, you will be able to interact in additional ways, including direct messaging and video chat.
- o You can also set up a time to meet virtually one-on-one.

Instructions For Presenters

Roles in the Session

- Announcer/Admin A NAHDO staff member will be in each session. This person will be responsible for handling all logistics, such as starting and ending the broadcast, monitoring the Chat and Q&A feeds, and keeping track of time. The announcer will lead off the session with any announcements or housekeeping details.
- **Moderator** The moderator will introduce the speakers and control the overall timing and flow of the session.
- **Speaker** The speaker is the heart of the session and should focus on presenting their content and information. Sessions have time allotted for questions from the attendees as well as discussion among the speakers.

Presentation files and slides

- **Format** Presenters should create their presentation materials as a PDF file. This will help ensure consistent formatting.
- Please send your presentation to info@nahdo.org at least 2 business days before your presentation.
- Speakers will generally use the Share a File (not "share screen") functionality to display their presentation. In case of malfunction, the admin for your session will be able to display your presentation, but you will need to indicate when to change slides.
- All presenters should have participated in a test session before the conference starts to allow us to troubleshoot connectivity issues.

How and when to join your session

Please join your session's Studio ten minutes beforehand.

• The best way to enter the Studio is through the "My Talks" link in the Event Lobby. If you cannot find the link, you can enter the Studio directly using the URL provided in the speaker invitation from Accelevents. Please make sure that you are using the links for the actual conference and not the test environment.

Special guidelines for "session only" registrants

 Speakers who are registered only for the session where they are presenting will not have access to the Lobby. You will receive an email with specific instructions on how to enter your Studio.

During the session

- Mic and Webcam Muting To minimize distractions and reduce the burden on bandwidth, please keep your mic and webcam on mute when you are not speaking (but don't forget to unmute).
- Camera Background Please be aware that attendees will be able to see what's behind you. Best practice is to remove any items that may be distracting to attendees. A plain wall or an office look would work well.

Special Notes

- Do **NOT** click Start Broadcast or Stop Broadcast. Those buttons are for the admin to control the video feed to the attendees.
- To leave the session use the **phone icon** on the left (5th down from the top on the list of control icons, left panel)
