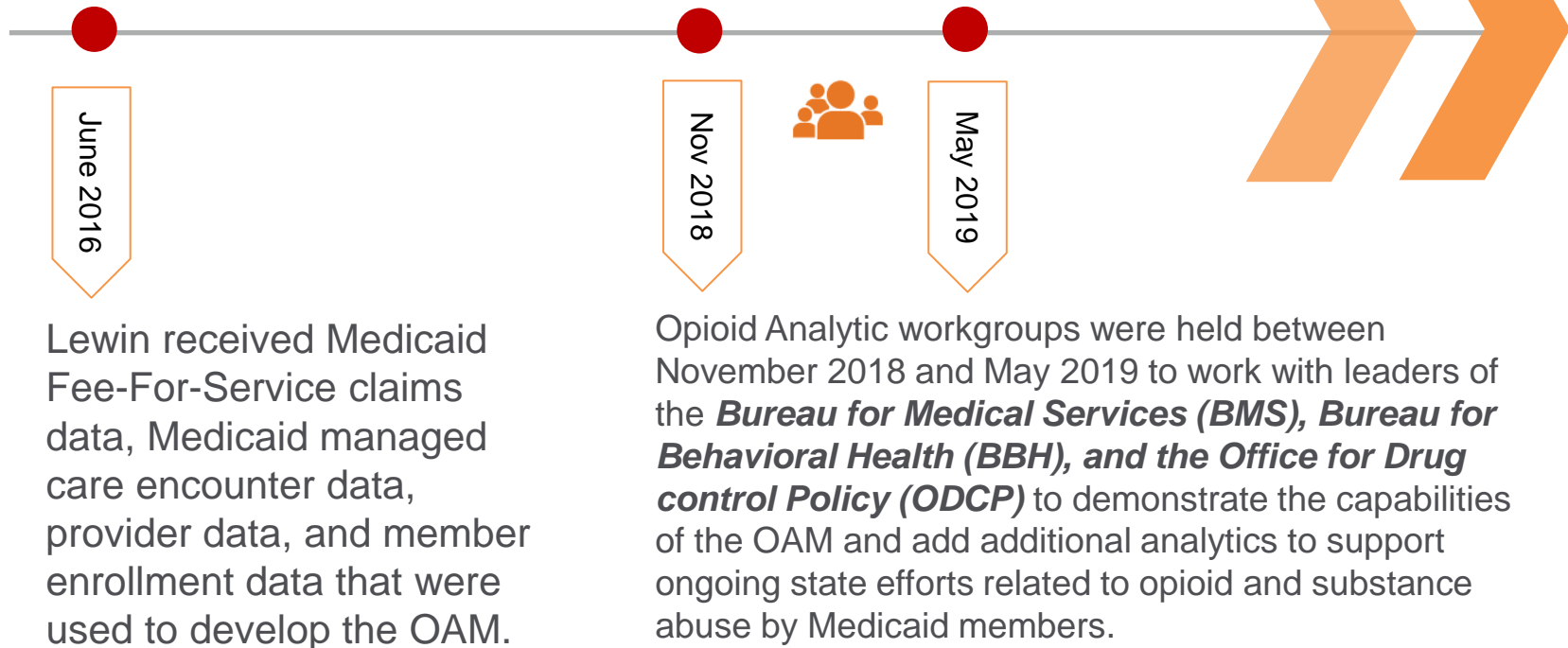




Opioid Analytics – Applications and Lessons Learned

## Background: Developing Analytics to Address Opioid Abuse

Lewin developed an Opioid Analytics Module (OAM) for the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR). The OAM includes data analytics to identify members, providers and counties with excessive opioid utilization.



## Opioid Analytic Module - Functionality

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- Provider monitoring and program integrity
- Pharmacy Lock-in program
- Improving access to treatment providers and facilities



- Utilization of SUD Waiver Services
- Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)
- Identify members with excessive opioid utilization

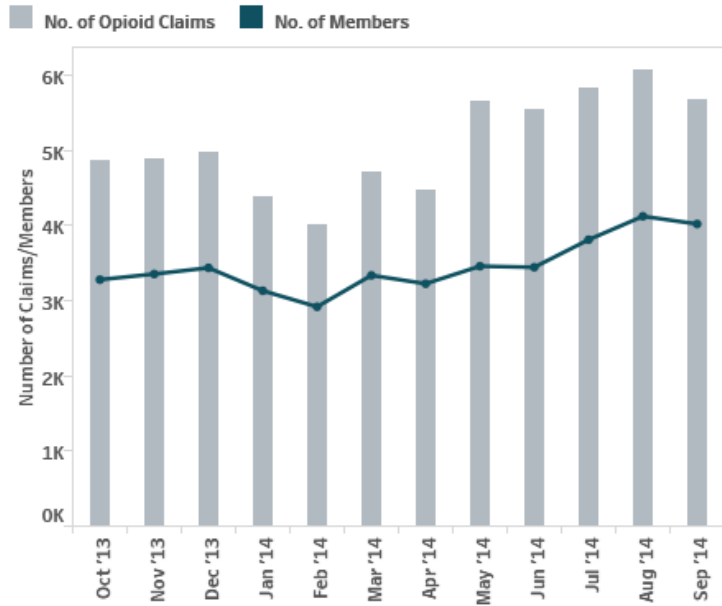

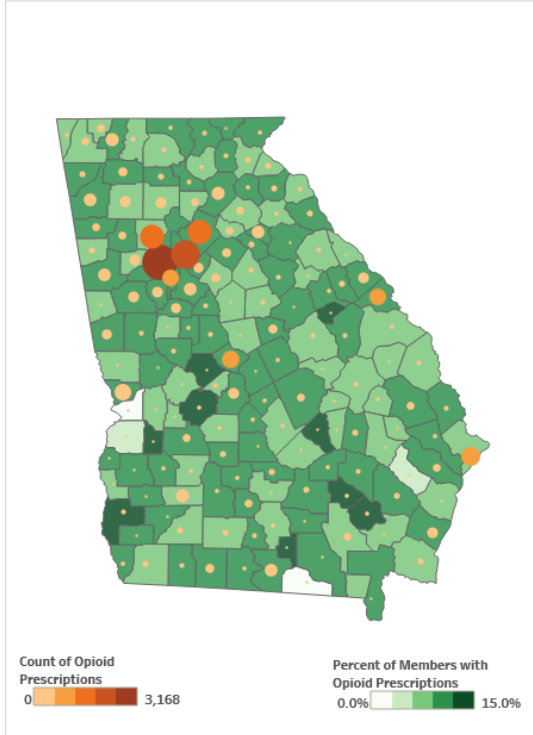

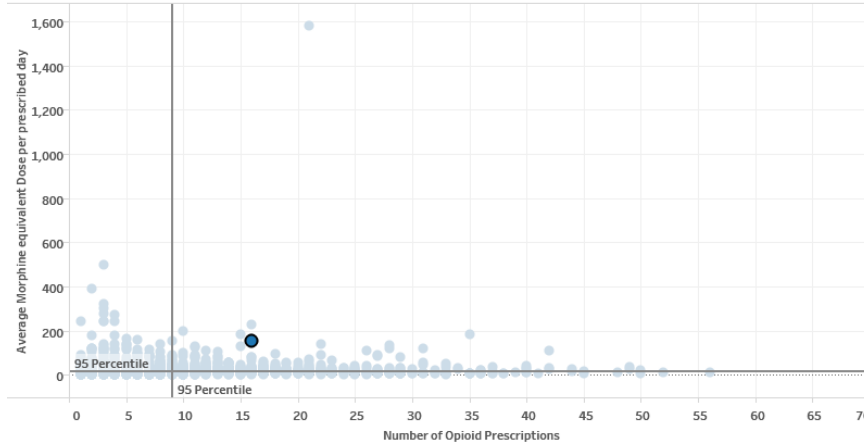

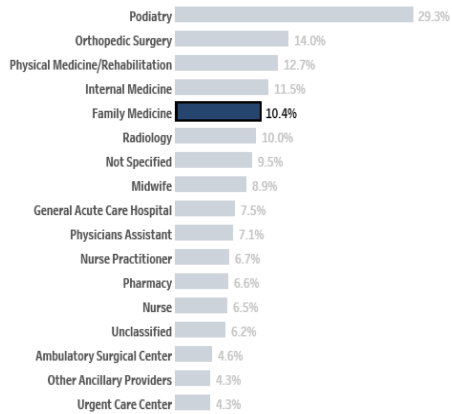

This bar graph shows the percent of members who were prescribed Opioid Prescriptions among all members that received prescriptions.

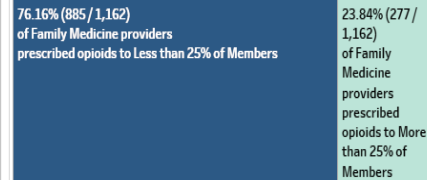
Select a Provider type to view what ratio of providers prescribed opioids to more than 25% of members who received a prescription.

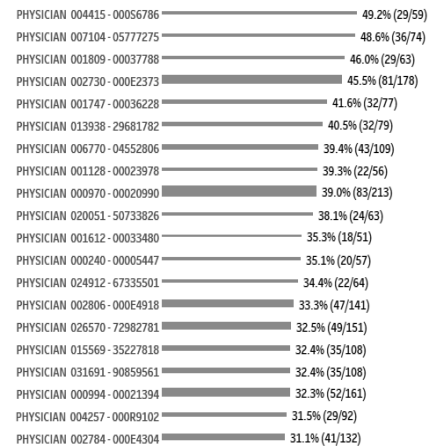

This shows the percent of members who received any prescription that were prescribed opioids by individual Family Medicine providers.

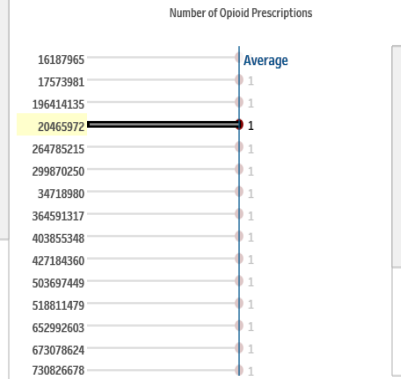

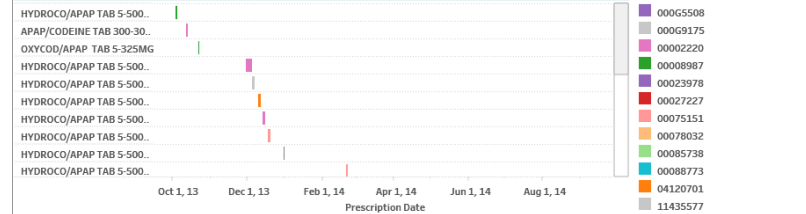

This shows all opioid prescriptions over time for Member 20465972. The length of the bar corresponds to the days supply of the prescription. The color denotes who the prescribing provider was.

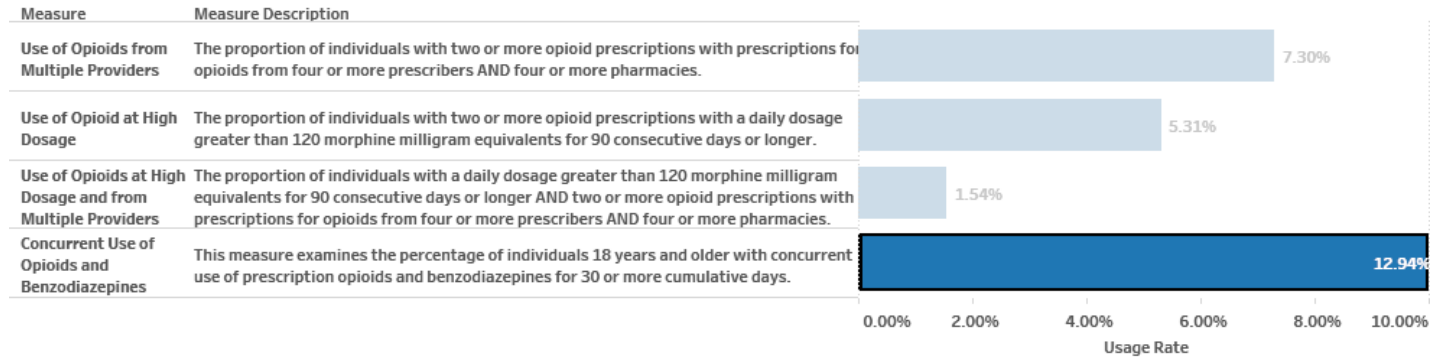






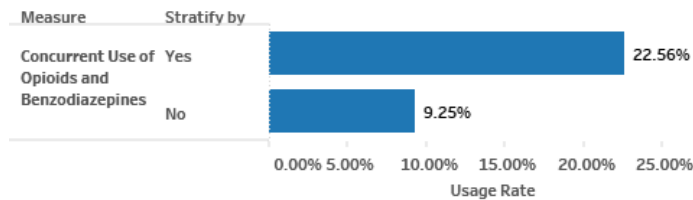

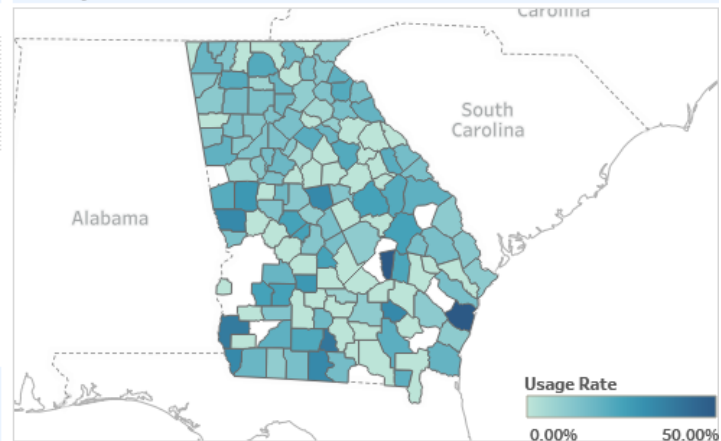

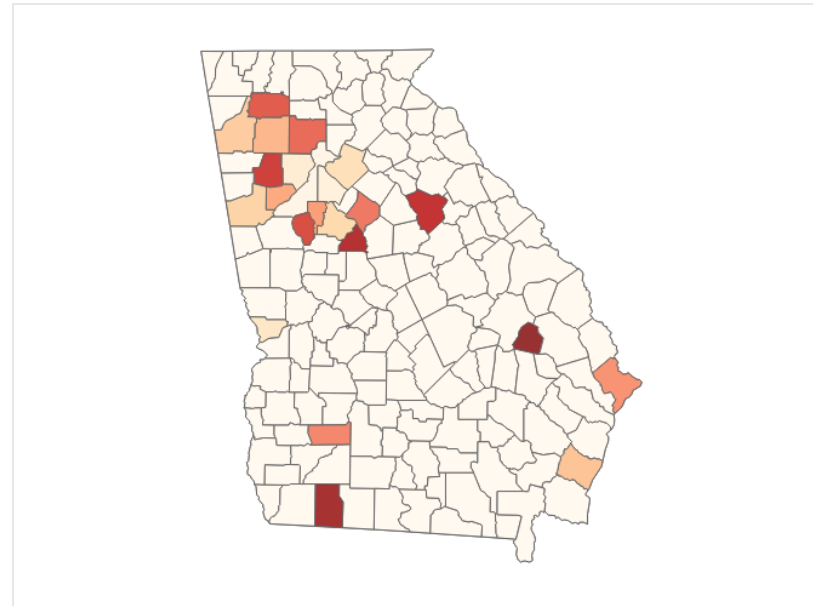

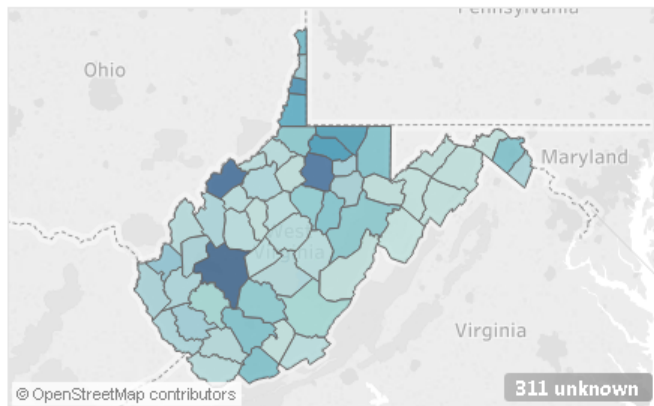

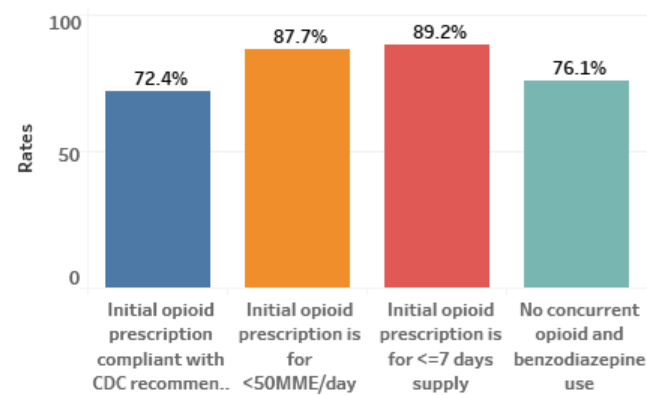

  - Analytics should **align** with the State's Substance Use disorder program from project initiation.
  - **Partnership** with health care providers is critical for program and policy success.
