


# Unique Considerations on Release

- Linkages

  - Medicaid
  - Medicare
- Sensitive Data
  - Fetal deaths
  - HIV/AIDS
  - Communicable diseases
  - Mental Health Treatment
  - Substance Abuse Treatment

- Expanded Content
  - Non-claims based payments
  - Plan benefit design
  - Premium information
  - Clinical/EHR data
  - Registries
  - Social determinants of health

# SPARCS File Type Descriptions

#### Three levels of access by file type:

| File type                                 | Contents  | SPARCS Application process  |

| Identifying/<br>Deniable Data<br>Requests | Contains data elements that if disclosed without any restrictions on use or redisclosure would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy   | <ul> <li>Must submit application</li> <li>Data Use Agreement(s)</li> <li>Must be approved by the Data Governance         Committee and ratified by the Commissioner     </li> </ul> |
| Limited                                   | Research-oriented data file that retains some of the direct and indirect identifiers (e.g., service date, DOB) for qualified researchers with appropriate DUAs in place and appropriate restrictions. | <ul> <li>Must submit application</li> <li>Data Use Agreement(s)</li> <li>Must be approved by program staff as legitimate use</li> </ul>   |
| Public Use Files                          | Contain de-identified data consisting of basic record-level detail. Public use files do not contain protected health information (PHI) under HIPAA  | <ul> <li>No application required</li> <li>Available on public<br/>websites (Health Data NY)</li> </ul>  |

# Vital Statistics

- Aggregated reports of Vital Statistics data made available on public website and the open data portal
- Separate governance structure for birth, pregnancy and mortality data between NYC and outside of NYC
- No identifiable birth or fetal death data are released external to the DOH
- Data requests for custom data reports are handled on a per request basis for protecting patient privacy (i.e. sufficient population / denominator)


Live Births Deaths Marriages / Pregnancies Dissolutions **Population**

### New York State Health Profiles

- Consumer facing DOH website for hospital, nursing home, home care, hospice and physician performance
  - Includes measures on quality, utilization, surveillance and services provided
  - Includes both NYS and national measures of provider quality
  - Ability to compare facilities and quality measures






### Health Data NY

- Open Data Portal for Health Data
  - Currently 150+ data sets available to the public
  - Includes financial, utilization, quality, public health, surveillance, provider network data and vital statistics (birth, death data)
  - Includes some de-identified discharge level data from the all payer hospital discharge data collection, including charges and costs (SPARCS)
- Other digital tools include: Quality
   Measurement (eQARR) and Managed Care




#### Health Data NY Stakeholder View




#### Data Available on Health Data NY

All data released on the open data portal is accompanied by an **Expert Determination** signed statement that the data are sufficiently deidentified to minimize risk of re-identification.



# Open Data – Expert Determination



- 1) **Expert Determination**, where statistical and scientific principles are applied to determine risk of identifying an individual.
- 2) **Safe Harbor**, includes a list of 18 identifiers of an individual (or of relatives, employers, or household members of the individual) that are removed from the data set.

- Names
- 2. Zip Codes (except first three)
- 3. All elements of dates (except year)
- 4. Telephone Numbers
- Fax Numbers
- Email Addresses
- Social Security Numbers
- 8. Medical record numbers
- 9. Health plan beneficiary numbers
- Account numbers
- 11. Certificate / license numbers
- 12. Vehicle identifiers and serial numbers, license plates
- Device identifiers and serial numbers.
- 14. Web Universal Resource Locators (URLs)
- Internet Protocol Addresses
- 16. Biometric identifiers (fingerprints, voice prints, retinal scans)
- 17. Full face photographic images
- 18. Any other unique identifying number, characteristic or code
