

The purpose of the Common Data Layout (CDL) for All-Payer Claims Databases (APCD-CDL[™]) is to harmonize the claims collection effort across states and reduce the burden of data submission. The overall goals of this effort are to improve efficiency, reduce administrative costs and improve accuracy in claims data collection.

APCD-CDL[™] Content



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
- Header and trailer records contained on all files
- Files
 - Member Eligibility
 - Medical Claims
 - Pharmacy Claims
 - Dental Claims
 - Provider File
- File content
 - Element name, data type, field length, field description/code, industry standards (in appendices)
- Consistent inter-file identifier

APCD-CDL[™], **Progress to Date**



- It all started with... a state response to Supreme Court decision in Gobeille v. Liberty Mutual
- Weekly calls from May 2016 June 2017 to review every proposed field with states, vendors and payers
- October 2018, states requested NAHDO/APCD Council make APCD-CDL[™] available
- December 2018, first version of APCD-CDL[™] was made available by request
- Starting in January 2019, APCD-CDL[™] advisory committee developed process for maintenance
