



Increasing number of lists needed in the Data Warehouse





Centralized, accessible tracking of release schedules





DWED for Data Intake




Example 1: Valid ICD-10 codes

- ► ICD-10 Code List → indication of invalid values present in ICD-10 fields
- ⇒ ICD-9 Code List → confirm whether values present in ICD-10 fields are ICD-9 codes, rather than some other type of data submission issue


Example 2: Valid National Provider ID

- ► NPI Registry List → applied to billing and servicing provider NPIs on claims
 - / High pass rate in 2017 APCD data



DWED for Reports



Example: Hospital ED-involved encounters with an external cause of injury code for unintentional fall


- → ED visits / list of revenue codes & CPT procedure codes → ED flag created in release datasets
- → ICD-10 Codes → select specified range of codes, valid codes only
- → AHRQ HCUP Clinical Classification Software (CCS) for ICD-10-CM \rightarrow List of diagnosis codes classified as "External cause codes: Fall"
- → ZIP Codes, States → remove encounters for outof-state patients
- → ICD-10 Code Descriptions → Add labels with detail about type of fall injury
- → Geographical Groupings → Crosswalk ZIP codes, add county labels, FIPS codes, longitude and latitude

DWED for Reports

- Facilitates reporting processes
- Adaptable to new or changing reporting needs
 - Established, efficient integration process for new lists
- Tracking historical versions of code sets
 - Longitudinal analyses
