# Current Uses of Hospitalization Data Community Health Assessment

<b>Diabetes</b> Amputation due to diabetes	<b>Asthma</b>
<b>Eating Disorders</b>	<b>Injury</b> Self inflicted injury Motor vehicle related injury
<b>Circulatory system diseases</b>	<b>Coronary heart disease</b>
<b>Acute myocardial infarction</b>	<b>Stroke</b> <b>COPD</b>
<b>Carbon monoxide poisoning</b>	<b>Congestive heart failure</b>

# Other DOH Uses for Hospitalization, Emergency Department, and Ambulatory Surgery Data

## **Wildfire Morbidity (2006-2007)**

Emergency Department and Hospitalizations

## **Anaphylaxis Study (2005-2006)**

Emergency Department

## **Ascertainment of Pregnancy-Associated Deaths (2000-2006)**

Female Deaths linked to Ambulatory Surgery, Emergency  
Department, and Hospitalizations

## **Late Preterm Birth & Cesarean Delivery Study (2005-2007)**

Births linked to Mother and Infant Hospitalizations

## **Florida Birth Defects Registry**

Births linked to Ambulatory Surgery and Hospitalizations

## **Florida Cancer Registry**

Registrants linked to Ambulatory Surgery, Emergency Department,  
and Hospitalizations

# Exchanging Identified Data

## AHCA - DOH

- Data Use Agreement for data exchange
- Secured data exchange established with quarterly releases
- Each user / purpose maintains individual data use agreements
- Authorization remains with owner agency
- Release of data is managed within the requestor's agency

# Benefits

- Single points of contact at each agency
  - Streamline request process
  - Streamline acquiring data
  - Streamline providing access to data
- Security is enhanced
  - Reduces the number of copies of the identified data
  - Reduces the number of data transfers

- Initial data exchange taking place March 2009
- Provide access for current recipients within the Florida Department of Health
- Develop expanded indicator listing – establish linkages as needed
